Proposed Bus Routes Changes

You may be aware that Transport for West Midlands (TFWM) published a consultation in October 2018 setting out proposals to change bus routes throughout Solihull Borough. The 88 service to Chadwick End was listed as being scrapped altogether, which meant that if adopted, we would not have any public transport links to and from our village. The introduction date of the revised servinces is 23 February 2019. As expected, residents were not happy with these proposals so two meetings have taken place at the village hall to discuss this further. Representations have subsequently been made to TFWM for their consideration
