The format of the questionnaire was recently finalised and it has now been printed. It will be hand delivered to and collected from all households in the Parish. This will hopefully take place April with collection two weeks later. The questionnaire seeks to gather views and opinions from Parish residents about a wide variety of topics that affect everyone one of us who live here. The completed questionnaires will remain confidential and will not be seen by either the Parish Plan Steering Group (PPSG) nor the Chadwick End Parish Councillors. Stratford District Council (SDC) have been commissioned to handle this process to maintain confidentiality. The results from the completed questionnaires will be analysed by SDC and supplied to the PPSG. These views and opinions will help to form the basis of the Parish Plan, which will be compiled by the PPSG. It should be ready for publication in Autumn 2016. Could we ask for two things please: 1) Please fully complete and return the questionnaire, your answers

and views are essential. 2) If you are willing to deliver/collect some questionnaires in your street or locality, get in touch with Hilary our Parish Clerk.
